Subject: Request for release of pending pension bills of State Universities – Reg

Respected Sir,

We, the retired teachers of Kakatiya University, Warangal, wish to bring to your kind notice a matter of urgent concern regarding the disbursement of pensions to retired teaching staff. As per the GO. Ms No. 277 issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh dated 02-12-19923, all the teaching staff of the of Kakatiya University have been governed by the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1992, and have been receiving our pension after being approved by the AG from the Government budget allocations.

Until recently, the University used to submit a consolidated bill covering both salaries and pensions under a single head, which used to be cleared without delay by the finance department and check was being issued

However, as per the recent instructions of the Principal Secretary, Finance, the University was now asked to submit separate claims for salaries and pensions. While the salary bills are being cleared, the pension bills for the months of July, August, September and October2025 remain pending, without release of funds from the Finance Department.

This has forced the Universities, which are already under severe financial stress, to draw upon their limited internal resources to meet the pension commitments of retired teachers. This situation is not sustainable and is causing great anxiety among the pensioners, who depend on timely pensions for their livelihood.

Under this helpless situation, we earnestly request your kind intervention to:

1. Instruct the Finance Department to immediately release the pending pension dues for the months of July, August, September and October 2025 to the University.
2. Restore the earlier practice of clearing consolidated salary and pension bills together under a single head, so that delays and financial hardship to University and pensioners are avoided.

We humbly seek your urgent attention to this matter in the interest of justice and the welfare of hundreds of retired teachers who have rendered their lifetime service to the cause of higher education in Telangana.
